2022 Annual Certification of Compliance with Home Care Worker Wage Parity Forms Available on eMedNY Provider Enrollment (PE) Portal



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This notice provides information for your organization on submission of the **2022 Annual Certification of Compliance with Home Care Worker Wage Parity** has been uploaded to the eMedNY Provider Enrollment (PE) Portal for completion.

Updated certification forms must be annually submitted to the DOH by Medicaid Managed Care plans and Managed Long Term Care plans (MCO), certified home health agencies (CHHA), long term home health care programs (LTHHCP), licensed home care services agencies (LHCSA) and consumer directed personal assistance program fiscal intermediaries (FI) in New York City and Westchester, Nassau and Suffolk counties.

Starting October 1, 2022, all MCOs, CHHAs, LTHHCPs, LHCSAs and FIs must submit the 2022 Annual Certification of Compliance with Home Care Worker Wage Parity electronically through the new [Provider Enrollment Portal](#). If you had previously registered for the Provisional Temporary Provider Enrollment (PTPE) Portal, you will need to re-register using the Provider Enrollment (PE) Portal to complete your certification of compliance. If you already have a Provider Enrollment (PE) Portal account, no re-registration is required. Instructions for completing the form are provided in [MLTC Policy 21.03](#).

In addition, please note that the clarification to MCOs provided in [MLTC Policy 21.03a](#) is still in effect.

As outlined in a letter sent and [posted](#) by the Department on August 18, 2022, the 2022 certification form delays the implementation of submission of the Department of Labor form LS300 until December 1,

2022 and the submission of the Department of Labor form LS301, with audited financial statements, until October 1, 2023 for both the 2021 and 2022 calendar years.
