Overview

NY.GOV ID is an online service that allows users to sign in securely to NY.GOV ID participating government online services.

A NY.GOV ID **business account is required** to access the NYS Medicaid Provider Services Portal (PSP) for new practitioner provider enrollment.


All practitioners, enrollment staff and credentialers working on new provider enrollment applications in the portal will be required to create their own NY.GOV ID business accounts. If you currently have an NY.GOV ID **personal** account, you will have to create a **business** account.

Please Note: Practitioners enrolling into NYS Medicaid using the NYS Medicaid Provider Services Portal will need their own business NY.GOV ID account to submit their application. Credentialers and office staff can start the application and fill out the required information, but they cannot submit the application on behalf of the provider.
