



Attention Pharmacy Providers- Important Information Regarding Drug Allocation/Shortages

Due to reported market shortages and allocation constraints, Medicaid Fee-for-Service (FFS) has relaxed prior authorization for certain drug(s)/drug classes to ensure access to necessary medications during the Declared Disaster Emergency in NY.

- ProAir HFA is a preferred product in the Inhaled Short-Acting Beta2 Adrenergic Therapeutic Class. If this product is not available, the following drugs are available without PA:
 - Albuterol HFA, levalbuterol HFA, ProAir Digihaler & RespiClick, Proventil HFA, Ventolin HFA and Xopenex HFA (**change made effective 3/19/20**)
- Flovent HFA is the preferred HFA product in the Inhaled Corticosteroids Therapeutic Class. If this product in not available, the following HFA inhaler is available without PA:
 - Asmanex HFA (**change made effective 3/30/20**)
- Generic azithromycin tablets are preferred over the brand products per substitution law. If this product is not available, the following brand drugs are available without PA:
 - Zithromax 250mg & 500mg tablets, Zithromax 1gm packet and Zithromax 100mg & 200mg suspensions (**change made effective 4/1/20**)
