





- The Department of Health announces the Medicaid expansion of douts services statewide for all Medicaid fee-for-service and Medicaid Managed Care enrollees.
- NYS Medicaid Members will be eligible for douls services up to 12 months after the end of pregnancy, regardless of pregnancy outcome.
- Interested doubse can apply for enrollment with NYS Medicaid either through the Work Experience Pathway or Training Pathway, Pathway requirements can be reviewed here or in the Doubs Services Provider Manual (once published).
- All doubles who were enrolled as NYS Medicaid doubs services providers in the doub pilot as of 2/29/2023 will have their enrollment extended through 2/28/2025, at which time they will have to reveilbale according to updated reveilbalidor requirements.
- The Medicald-enrolled doubt services provider may be reimbursed for up to eight perinatal visits and one labor and delivery encounter per pregnancy.
- As of 3/1/2024, all Medicaid Members will be eligible for douts services under the statewide douts services benefit regardless of the douts services they may have received with the pilot.
- To become a douls services provider for NYS Medicaid Managed Care members, a douls must first enroll as a billing provider with the NYS Medicaid Fee-for-Service Program.
- Once enrolled as a NYS Medicald Fee-for-Service billing douls services provider, a douls can then reach out to the Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) to apply to join the MCO's douls provider network.
